How to create an account and login details

- Go to <u>www.effcaccidentreports.org</u> (or use the link on <u>www.foundationworld.org</u>)
- Click on the 'register' button

- You will receive a confirmation mail with your activation link

The programme is self-explanatory and requires no special knowledge.
